Re: FY2022 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG)

Notice of Availability of Funding/Application

Lucas County has FY22 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) federal funds available to allocate through the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA). These funds are available to establish or enhance programs with a focus on state and local initiatives, technical assistance, training, personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support and information systems for criminal justice in qualifying purpose areas as identified in the RFP.

Eligible applicants must be a general-purpose unit of local government (e.g., county, city, township, village) or combined units of government (e.g., Council of Government), or a non-profit organization. The local cash or inkind match requirement is 25 percent for all eligible projects

Projects receiving subgrant awards may anticipate a 12-month project period beginning January 1, 2024 and ending December 31, 2024. Projects receiving awards will be expected to complete their stated activities within the 12-month project period.

All JAG proposals must be received by **July 19, 2023 by 4:00 PM**. **Applications must be submitted on line through Zengine at:** <a href="https://webportalapp.com/sp/cjcc-fy22jag">https://webportalapp.com/sp/cjcc-fy22jag</a>. Additional information is available on the CJCC website under the grants section.

A bidder's training will be held on **June 21, 2023 at 2:00 PM** via Zoom to review requirements and materials required to submit a successful application. If you plan to attend the bidders training, please send an email listing your name, agency, and email address to grants@noris.org.

Projects will also be required to submit a five (5) minute video to include a summary of the program, accomplishments and other pertinent information in lieu of a presentation to the Allocation Review Committee. More information will be forthcoming after submittal of the application.
