Re: FY2025 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG)
Notice of Availability of Funding/Application

Lucas County has \$77,955.50 in FY25 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) federal funds available to allocate to one or more programs through the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA). These funds are available to establish or enhance programs with a focus on state and local initiatives, technical assistance, training, personnel, equipment, supplies, contractual support and information systems for criminal justice in qualifying purpose areas as identified in the RFP.

Eligible applicants must be a general-purpose unit of local government (e.g., county, city, township, village) or combined units of government (e.g., Council of Government), or a non-profit organization. The local cash or in-kind match requirement is 25 percent for all eligible new projects. Continuation projects will follow the step-down match process as outlined on page 6 in the RFP guidelines.

Projects receiving subgrant awards may anticipate a 12-month project period beginning January 1, 2027 and ending December 31, 2027. Projects receiving awards will be expected to complete their stated activities within the 12-month project period.

All JAG proposals must be received by **4:00 PM Friday, August 28, 2026**. **Applications must be submitted online through the online grant management system: [Foundant](#).** No late applications will be accepted. Projects will also be required to submit a five (5) minute video to include a summary of the program, accomplishments and other pertinent information in lieu of a presentation to the Allocation Review Committee. More information will be forthcoming after submittal of the application.
