Re: FY2019 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Solicitation  
Notice of Funding Availability/Grant Application

Lucas County has FY2019 Federal JAG funds available to allocate through the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP) and the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA). Applicants must apply under one of the following JAG program areas: A) Law Enforcement, B) Crime Prevention, C) Adult and Juvenile Corrections, Community Corrections and Reentry, D) Courts, Defense, Prosecution and Victim Services or E) Cross-Agency and Cross-System Collaboration, Training and Research. Eligible JAG applicants include a unit of local government, local agencies, local-supported universities, local non-profit or faith-based associations or law enforcement agencies. The local cash or in-kind match requirement is 25 percent for all eligible JAG projects.

Applications are due June 29, 2020 by 4:30 PM. Please refer to the Request for Proposals (RFP) for submission information.
