FY2018 Title II Formula Grant Solicitation
Notice of Funding Availability/Grant Application

Lucas County has FY2017 and FY2018 Federal JAG funds available to allocate through the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP) and the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA). Applicants must apply under one of the following JAG program areas: A) Law Enforcement, B) Crime Prevention, C) Adult and Juvenile Corrections, Community Corrections and Reentry, D) Courts, Defense, Prosecution and Victim Services or E) Cross-Agency and Cross-System Collaboration, Training and Research. Eligible JAG applicants include a unit of local government, local agencies, local-supported universities, local non-profit or faith-based associations or law enforcement agencies. The local cash or in-kind match requirement is 25 percent for all eligible JAG projects.

In addition, Lucas County has FY2018 Title II Formula Grant funds available to allocate through the Ohio Department of Youth Services (DYS). CJCC is soliciting applications for programs, services and system improvement activities that are likely to reduce racial disparity in the local juvenile justice system by reducing arrests of minority youth. Eligible Title II applicants include a unit of local government, local agencies/associations, local universities or an official(s) of private or nonprofit agencies.

Projects receiving subgrant awards may anticipate a 12-month project period that will begin July 1, 2019 and end June 30, 2020. Projects receiving awards are expected to complete their stated activities within the project period.

Applications are due April 12, 2019 by 4:30 PM. Please refer to the Request for Proposals (RFP) for submission information.
